Oakley - Franson Lane Trail

Franson Lane Trail Rules:

1. Absolutely NO shooting on City property!
2. Respect all surrounding private property and livestock.
3. No alcohol, glass bottles, fires, or fireworks.
4. No motorized vehicles allowed on trails.
5. Clean up all trash. Leave this area cleaner than when you came here.
6. ALL Dogs MUST be kept ON Leash!
7. Bag and pack out all dog waste.
8. Cyclist must yield to all other users.
9. Park only in marked or designated stalls.



Total out and back trail distance following the Loop Trail = 1.1 Miles

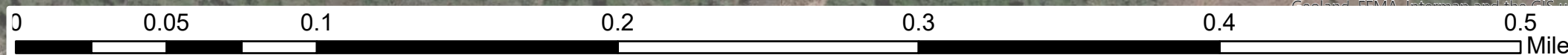
PARK TRAIL LENGTHS:
